Teachers	<p>Will use the new reading curriculum to differentiate instruction for the variety of learners in each class. Use supplemental leveled readers from the National Geographic.</p> <p>Will communicate with families about child's progress on a regular basis.</p>
Non-Teaching staff	<p>Help to set a reading example.</p> <p>Teach students to access the A.R. tests and results on the computers.</p> <p>Proctoring the MAP tests in fall and spring.</p> <p>Help student access library and media resources.</p> <p>Support and assist classroom instruction and student independent/centers work time.</p>
Budget	<p>Some dollars will be needed to label A.R. books.</p> <p>R. I. F. funds will be important to encourage the importance of reading and owning one's own books.</p>
Technology/ Pedagogy/ Facility	<p>Accelerated Reader books must continue to be identified and labeled.</p> <p>CD – students can use with class or independently.</p>
Community	<p>Families will be informed of the goals for their child's learning and encouraged to work with the classroom teacher and child to reach those goals.</p> <p>Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe Youth Program will provide transportation for the after school program.</p> <p>Community Education – College for Kids, ICC</p> <p>R.S.V.P. tutors will listen to young readers and encourage their improvement.</p> <p>Americorps Volunteer Project (pending)</p>
