Gear

Please make sure your iPad is charged and ready to go. Please also make sure you have your email and Schoology login information. Students in ConnectEd will have the same expectations as students in-person.

Logging In

Schoology will be the official learning platform for both in-person and ConnectEd students; Zoom will be used for student and teacher interactions in virtual classrooms. Test your child's log in before September 8 and contact their teacher with any issues. Classes will "turn on" Tuesday morning at 8:30 am and students must log in at that time to be considered present. 9-12 students must interact daily with each classroom teacher in order to be marked present.

Digital Citizenship

Daily Routines

Teachers will offer Office Hours every school day. This time is set aside to communicate with students. At 8:30 am, students will begin a traditional 7-period day. ConnectEd courses may be a combination of direct instruction from the teacher and independent exploration of concepts.

Grab & Go Meals will be available for families to purchase Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Pick up is from 10:00 am - 10:15 am outside the main entrance of GRHS.
