

# High School First Day Reminders



## Health Check

Please make sure your child is not feeling ill or exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms. A list of symptoms is available on our website at [isd318.org](http://isd318.org) when you choose the COVID-19 tab. If your student has symptoms, is awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test, or has been exposed to someone who has tested positive, please contact our school office at 218-743-3444.

## Gear

Don't forget your mask and refillable water bottle. Students in grades 6-12 may use their lockers to store items at the beginning of the day, but will not be allowed to access their lockers again until the end of the school day.

## Arrival

Students should arrive after 8:00 am. Only high school students will use the main entrance for arrival. There will be one lane of traffic for both buses and parent drop-offs. Please make sure your student has their mask on when entering a school bus or building. Non-essential visitors will not be allowed to walk children into the building. Thank you for understanding that it is for everyone's safety.

## Daily Routines

Students should clean masks or wear a new one each day. Students will have opportunities for mask breaks throughout the day.

## Navigating

Staff will be stationed around the building helping students get to classes and to find their way. We know that with new routines, kids may be nervous. We promise we'll take good care of them.

## Meals

Students may bring their lunch or have school meals. School meals will be eaten in the school commons unless distancing requirements result in the need to eat in classrooms.

## Dismissal

Make sure your student knows how they are getting home. We will have a controlled release to maximize physical distancing and only high school students will exit through the main doors. Parents picking up high school students should make arrangements to meet outside the school building.
