STUDENT ITEMS

- Backpack (Small/Medium size that fits in student lockers)
- Crayola Broadline Classic Color Markers (1 pack)
- Crayola Colored Pencils (1 pack)
- Crayola Crayons (2 packs of 24 count)
- Hand Sanitizer (small, for personal use and must be unscented)*
- Headphones/Earbuds (small enough to fit in a Ziploc bag or pencil box)
- Large Pink Erasers (2)
- Masks (Washable/Reusable Face Masks)**
- Non-marking sneakers for Phy Ed
- Paint shirt and towel for rest time (Kindergarten Only)
- Pencil Box/Bag
- Pencils (2 Dozen Ticonderoga PreSharpened or any "Made in USA" brand)
- Water Bottle

Each student gets their own journal and will add things to it, like photos, videos, drawings, or notes.



When there are new Seesaw posts, families can be notified via app notification, email, or text message.

Parents are only notified about their own child's work or group work, and all data is safe and secure.
