Grand Rapids High School has an open enrollment policy for students who wish to take IB courses and for those students who wish to attempt the IB Diploma. This policy is widely communicated. The IB Coordinator goes into both 9th and 10th grade classrooms to share this philosophy and to explain the program to students. GRHS IB Brochures are given out to students. The philosophy is also shared through the GRHS website and to parents at information sessions.

The GRHS IB Coordinator has multiple information sessions each year for students who have expressed interest in learning more about the IB Diploma after hearing about the program in the 9th and 10th grade classes. Typically, the Extended Essay Coordinator and the CAS Coordinator are part of these meetings. Students who express further interest after attending these informational sessions have one on one meetings with the IB Coordinator to plan out schedules and further instruct students in the IB Diploma program and philosophy.
