# **IB COLLEGE CREDIT POLICIES AT VARIOUS REGIONAL UNIVERSITIES**

#### **UNIVERSITY of MINNESOTA**

Students in IB programs receive eight semester credits at the University of Minnesota for each higher-level subject passed with a grade of five or higher. Those who earn the full IB diploma with 30 or more diploma points receive eight semester credits for each higher level subject with grades of five or higher, and up to two semester credits for each standard level subject with grades of five or higher. In other words, the diploma program amounts to about one full year of University work!

# MN STATE COLLEGE & UNIVERSITIES including: BEMIDJI STATE, ST. CLOUD STATE, MSU-MANKATO, MSU-MOORHEAD, WINONA STATE, AND ALL COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND TECH SCHOOLS

Student shall receive three (3) or more course credits for scores of 4 or higher on individual Higher Level IB examinations and two (2) or more credits for scores of 4 or higher on individual Standard Level IB examinations. Students who attain an IB diploma shall be granted six (6) credits for scores of 4 or higher on HL IB examinations and two (2) credits for scores of 4 or higher on higher on each SL IB examination.

#### AUGUSTANA COLLEGE-SOUTH DAKOTA

Augustana College will grant credit on a course-by-course basis for IB higher level examinations in which the student has received a grade of 5 or higher.

## **BETHEL UNIVERSITY**

Bethel awards credit only for Higher Level IB Examinations. A student may receive up to eight semester credits for each HL Examination completed with a score of five or higher.

# CARLETON COLLEGE

Carleton College grants course credits for IB higher level examinations as outlined below. More specific information can be obtained from the college course catalogue, the registrar's office, or the admission office.

CHEMISTRY—Score of 4: Placement is awarded into Chemistry 123 or 128. Score of 5 or higher: 6 credits are granted that count toward the chemistry major and placement is awarded into Chemistry 230 (Equilibrium and Analysis). Students receiving this IB credit cannot also get credit for Chemistry 123 or 128.

ENGLISH— Score of 5 or higher: 6 credits granted.

- HISTORY—Score of 5 or higher: 6 credits granted for each exam. The History department grants credit toward the major and toward the "Early Modern/Modern Europe" field within the major for scores of 5, 6, or 7 on the IB HL examination in European history.
- PHYSICS— Score of 5 or higher: 6 credits granted. Placement into courses will be determined individually upon consultation with the Department.

# **COLLEGE OF ST. SCHOLASTICA**

Students who have been formally admitted at the College of St. Scholastica may petition for up to 4 transfer credits for each IB course completed with a higher level examination grade of 4 or above. The acceptability of a course will be determined by the related academic department at the College. In general, elective transfer credit will be awarded, but in some cases, the transferred credit may be used in lieu of credit in equivalent, specifically required Scholastica courses.

#### HAMLINE UNIVERSITY

Students may receive Hamline credit for completing the IB higher level examinations, with a score of 5 or better, from the following subject areas: biology, chemistry, physics, economics, mathematics, psychology, philosophy, music, English and foreign language. Subjects not listed will be reviewed by the appropriate departments. If requested, students should be prepared to supply supporting documentation, course descriptions, syllabi, papers and/or tests. A maximum of twenty credits may be transferred through the IB Diploma Program.

#### MACALESTER

Students whose scores on higher level examinations of the IB Diploma Program are 5, 6, or 7 receive the equivalent of 4 or 8 semester hours of credit for each such examination. Credit is determined by the appropriate academic department on an individual basis and is subject to the following limitation: Macalester will accept for credit no more than the equivalent of 20 semester hours from courses earned prior to graduation from high school

#### NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY

North Dakota State University recognizes the International Baccalaureate Diploma program. Students must receive a minimum score of four on higher level examinations to qualify for possible awarding of credit and advanced placement, which is determined by the appropriate academic department on campus

# NORTH DAKOTA UNIVERSITY SYSTEM (including UND)

Credit is granted for IB Higher Level scores of 4 or higher in English (3 credits granted), History of Europe (3 credits), Chemistry (8-10 credits), and score of 5 or higher in Physics (4 credits).

#### ST. MARY'S UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA

Students with International Baccalaureate (IB) test scores of 4 through 7 may request credit and advanced placement by submitting the scores to the registrar. Saint Mary's University accepts IB scores only on the Higher Level exams; with the exception of foreign languages, where both the Higher Level and Standard Level are accepted.

## ST. OLAF

Upon receipt of official documentation, and with certain departmental restrictions, St. Olaf awards credit only for scores of "5" through "7" on the Higher Level Exams of the High School International Baccalaureate Program. In exceptional circumstances, Standard Level (SL) exams may be considered for credit, at the discretion of a department or program.

#### **UNIVERISTY OF MN- MORRIS**

Students who complete an International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma with a score of 30 or higher

and have no examination scores lower than 4 are awarded 8 credits for each of three higher level courses, plus 2 credits for each of three standard level courses, for a total of 30 credits.

No credit is given for SL courses other than those included as part of the IB diploma, but students may receive credit for any higher level courses with a score of 5 or higher. The Scholastic Committee has approved use of IB credits to meet specific general education categories. Use of IB credits in the major is determined through discussions between students and faculty in each major.

# UNIVERSITY OF ST THOMAS

Students who pass the IB examination(s) in subjects included in the St. Thomas curriculum with a score of 4 will ordinarily receive four semester credits toward graduation. Students who receive a score of 5-7 will ordinarily receive eight semester credits toward graduation. The specific courses for which credit would be awarded will be determined by the appropriate academic department.

Students who receive the full IB Diploma with a minimum score of 28 are eligible for 3 additional elective credits.

# UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN SYSTEM (SUPERIOR, RIVER FALLS, STOUT, etc...)

All University of Wisconsin System campuses award college credit for scores of 4-7 on (HL) IB examinations. Additional credit will be awarded to students who complete the full diploma program. Most campuses do not award degree credit for IB (SL) examination results. Check with the campus admission office for award of credit for SL examination results.
