Security Counselors are responsible for ensuring the safety and security of clients, staff, and visitors of the Moose Lake campus of the Minnesota Sex Offender Program. Throughout their shift, Security Counselors interact with clients, modeling positive and appropriate behaviors, minimizing risks, and anticipating safety/security concerns. Inherent in each of these activities, Security Counselor's apply facility policies and procedures to maintain a therapeutic atmosphere that supports the agency mission, vision and goals. This includes supporting individual clients in meeting their individual treatment plan expectations.

- Possess a High School diploma or GED and be at least 18 years of age and have at least ONE of the following in order to qualify for further consideration:
  - One or more years of full-time work experience in ANY field; **OR**
  - Two or more years of part-time work experience in ANY field.

The Minnesota Sex Offender Program (MSOP) is a sex offense specific treatment program in a modified therapeutic community in a secure setting that provides comprehensive services to 740 clients that are civilly committed as sexual psychopathic personalities or sexually dangerous persons. Comprehensive services include sex offense specific treatment, education programming, therapeutic recreation, vocational programming and volunteer services, and health and wellness. Safety and security are at the forefront while maintaining a therapeutic environment.
