

522 TITLE IX SEX NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY

PURPOSE

Students are protected from discrimination on the basis of sex pursuant to Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and the Minnesota Human Rights Act. The purpose of this policy is to provide equal educational opportunity for all students and to prohibit discrimination on the basis of sex.

522 TITLE IX SEX NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY**I. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY**

- A. Grand Rapids Area Schools does not discriminate on the basis of sex and prohibits sex discrimination in any education program or activity that it operates, as required by Title IX and its regulations, including in admission and employment.
