Along with our partnered district (ISD 317), we built a cohort of staff members that meets once per month. The goal of the cohort is to build a strong foundational relationship in which we can share opportunities (specifically cultural, experiential activities) for staff and students to increase cultural awareness. Although the focus of the cohort shifts as needs are addressed, the main focus is collaboration on professional development to ensure our staff members can continue on their journey towards being culturally aware.

The implementation of AVID over the course of the past three years has been a collaborative effort between the two districts. As the implementation is becoming sustainable at the site level, the growth and collaboration between the AVID Elective classes is becoming a more common practice. Our goal is to increase the number of American Indian students enrolled, therefore increasing our collaboration and opportunities between sites allows for a wide range of opportunities for students.
