2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

During the 2020-2021 School Year, we learned more about how to make quarantines most effective with the least possible impact to learning. We've used that information to guide our quarantine decision tree.

	If the COVID positive person IS wearing a face covering properly.	If the COVID positive person IS NOT wearing a face covering properly.
<p>If you have a close contact and are:</p>   <p>✓ fully vaccinated ✓ wearing a face covering properly</p>	 No quarantine	 No quarantine
<p>If you have a close contact and are:</p>  <p>✓ fully vaccinated ✗ NOT wearing a face covering</p>	 No quarantine	 No quarantine
<p>If you have a close contact and are:</p>  <p>✗ NOT fully vaccinated ✓ wearing a face covering properly</p>	 No quarantine	 No quarantine
<p>If you have a close contact and are:</p>  <p>✗ NOT fully vaccinated ✗ NOT wearing a face covering</p>	 10-DAY QUARANTINE	 10-DAY QUARANTINE
<p>If you have a positive case in your home and are:</p>  <p>✓ fully vaccinated</p>	 No quarantine	
<p>If you have a positive case in your home and are:</p>  <p>✗ NOT fully vaccinated</p>	 14-DAY QUARANTINE	

*If a family member is positive for COVID and you are vaccinated, you should wear a mask in public and seek testing after three to five days.

+If you develop symptoms at any point, regardless of mask or vaccination status, you should stay home and get a COVID test.
