There are school computers available for student use in classrooms and labs. When students use these resources they must:

- 1. Take responsibility for their actions while using the school's computers, network and the internet.
- 2. Use the internet only as a tool for classroom assignments and school related topics.
- 3. Realize that copyright information and graphics can be used only after the author has given written permission.
- 4. Only access files they have been authorized to access.
- 5. Only send and receive e-mail using their assigned district accounts. Both sent and received messages must be respectful and follow District policies and guidelines.
- 6. Refrain from sharing personal information about themselves and others on the internet.
- 7. Be conscientious when using limited resources, such as paper or time.
- 8. Use all technology hardware responsibly. Any deliberate tampering or misuse of the District's network or equipment will be considered vandalism and handled as such.
