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1. All vehicles parked on campus must be registered with the school and must display the current parking permit on the rearview mirror.
 2. Student parking is restricted to the designated "Student Parking Area" only and is strictly enforced. Faculty parking, visitor parking and Reif Center parking areas are OFF LIMITS TO ALL STUDENTS AT ALL TIMES.
 3. All students are required to be licensed and have valid proof of insurance. The school is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents.
 4. Hanging out/Loitering in the parking lot is not tolerated. Permission is required for any student not currently attending GRHS to be on campus or the in the parking area.
 5. There will be no speeding (over 5 mph) or any other form of reckless driving on campus.
 6. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe drugs, alcohol, stolen property or other contraband might be present in the vehicle.
 7. Parking regulations are strictly enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on campus. Suspension of parking privileges, towing of vehicles and/or suspension from school may occur when violations of these regulations occur.
 8. Above student has my permission to drive the vehicle described above to school. It is understood that the violation of any of the driving and parking regulations listed on page 2 may result in suspension of this privilege.

There will be no temporary parking passes issued for any reason. Vehicles not displaying parking permits will promptly be removed from school property at owner's expense.

Tampering with information on the parking permit may result in the loss of parking rights and even suspension.

Any student found allowing someone else to use their parking permit will immediately lose their parking privileges.

1. All vehicles require parking permits. Applications must be filled out completely. A nonrefundable fee of \$50 must accompany all applications.
2. Limit one parking permit per student. Lost parking permits may be replaced one time only at full price \$50.
3. Students must lock their vehicles. The school is not responsible for theft of parking permits and/or any items removed from vehicles.
4. Students are not allowed to sit in their cars or loiter in the parking lot during the school day. This includes during lunches.
5. Parking lot speed is 5 mph. Speeding or reckless driving will not be tolerated.
6. Student vehicles may be searched if there is a reason to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property and/or other contraband may be present in the vehicle.
7. The school district is not responsible for any theft or damage to vehicles on campus. If you have an accident, report it to the Grand Rapids Police Dept.
8. By law, you are required to have an auto insurance identification card in the vehicle at all times. Also, your vehicle must be properly equipped with muffler, two license plates, etc.
9. Students are forbidden from occupying the rear box/bed of pickup trucks.
10. Motorcycle drivers are required to abide by the above rules and have an appropriately endorsed driver's license. Helmets are mandatory on campus.
11. Vehicles must be parked straight, occupying only one space. Vehicles are not to block drive-thru and/or delivery areas.
12. Parking on campus is a privilege. Regulations will be strictly enforced.
13. Once your parking permit is suspended/revoked your vehicle is not to be parked on campus for any period of time, unless authorized by administration.
