Parking Is A Privilege

Parking on campus at Grand Rapids High School is a privilege. In order to enjoy this privilege you must be a student in good standing. The good news is that all students begin the school year as a "student in good standing." You can maintain this status by avoiding truancy, discipline referrals or leaving during lunches.

- 1. If you leave campus during lunch without permission (first offense) your parking privilege will be revoked.
- 2. The third time you are truant from class, your parking privilege may be suspended.
- 3. The third time you receive a disciplinary referral (including tardies), your parking privilege will be revoked.
- 4. If you are taking other students off campus without prior authorization, your parking privileges may be revoked.

Grand Rapids High School - Student Parking Permit Regulations

There will be no temporary parking permits issued for any reason. Vehicles not displaying parking permits will promptly be removed from school property at owner's expense.

Tampering with information on the parking permit may result in the loss of parking rights and even suspension.

Any student found allowing someone else to use their parking permit will immediately lose their parking privileges.

- 1. All vehicles require parking permits. Applications must be filled out completely. Nonrefundable fee of **\$50** (\$25 at 3rd Quarter) must accompany all applications.
 - Limit one parking permit per student. Lost parking permits may be replaced one time (only!) at full price \$50 (\$25 at 3rd Quarter).

Students must lock their vehicles. The school is not responsible for theft of parking permits and/or any items removed from vehicles.

- 2. Parking permits must be hung on the rearview mirror post. Motorcycle owners are to see Officer Koenig for placement of parking permits.
- 3. Students are not allowed to sit in cars or loiter in the parking lot during the school day. This includes during lunches.
- 4. Parking lot speed limit is 5 m.p.h. Speeding or reckless driving on campus will not be tolerated.
- 5. Student vehicles may be searched if there is reason to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property or other contraband might be present in the vehicle.
- 6. The school district is not responsible for any theft or damage to vehicles on campus. If you have an accident, report it to the Grand Rapids Police Department.
- 7. By law, you are required to have an auto insurance card in the vehicle. Also, your vehicle must be properly equipped with muffler, two license plates, etc.
- 8. Students are forbidden to occupy the rear box of pickup trucks on campus.
- 9. Motorcycles drivers are required to abide by the above rules and have an appropriately endorsed driver's license. Helmets are mandatory.
- 10. **Vehicles must be parked straight, occupying one space.** Vehicles are not to block drive-thru and/or delivery areas. ie., driveway going around to Tech Center
- 11. Parking on campus is a privilege. Regulations will be strictly enforced.
 - A. 1st Violation: Loss of parking privilege for a minimum of one week or revocation.
 - B. 2nd Violation: Loss of parking privilege for a minimum of one month or revocation.
 - C. 3rd Violation: Loss of parking privilege for remainder of school year.
- 12. Once your parking permit is suspended/revoked your vehicle is not to be parked on campus for any period of time, unless authorized by the proper authorities.
