

Hello Bigfork School Community:

We have been notified of a lab confirmed case of COVID-19 in a member of our learning community. The confirmed case was in your child's [classroom or grade level] with an exposure date of 9/9 and 9/10.

We recommend that all people in our learning environments wear a mask or face covering.

You should begin watching your child for symptoms. If your child has any symptoms, they must stay home for ten days or until they receive a negative COVID-19 test. Testing should be done 3-5 days after exposure. Please report all positive cases or self-quarantines to your building nurse.

The health, safety, and well-being of our school community remains our top priority. We are following the recommendations of the Minnesota Departments of Health and Education to ensure we are doing everything we can to protect your student's health. We also want to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the importance of wearing masks, social distancing, and regularly washing your hands. We are asking all members of our community to lower their risk of COVID-19 by considering the following:
