We are excited to announce that this year each student in grades 7-12 will have opportunity to receive a district iPad for school use. Prior to allowing students to bring devices home, each family will need to meet the following list of parent and student requirements:

Watch a family video presentation and complete a Video Presentation Response Form
Review the ISD 318 1-1 Digital Student Learning Initiative (DSLi): Family Handbook
Review the District iPad Insurance Plan (and make payment if selected)
Review, print and sign the ISD 318 1:1 Digital Student Learning Initiative Required Form

Please note that these requirements apply to all high school students even though they may have completed a similar process last year.

We have created an online course where you can complete this required process via computer. You may access the video and all forms at: https://www.isd318.org/Page/300. All forms are listed on the right hand side of the web page. If you would prefer, you may pick up these forms in the Bigfork School office, or call the office to request that the forms are mailed to you.

iPads will be distributed to students within the first two weeks of school to all who have completed the requirements.
