SCHOOL WEATHER CLOSINGS

“We want to remind you that the district now has the option to open late and to determine weather closures based on location. The district determines if a snow day or late start is necessary with input from local officials, neighboring districts and the district transportation staff. Members of the Transportation Department drive roads and check with city and county public works staff between 4 and 5 a.m. to determine if streets are open and buses can get through.
